<b>Word/Term</b>	<b>Part of Speech</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>civil disobedience</b>	noun	the refusal to obey certain laws as a form of political protest
<b>economic freedom</b>	noun	the freedom to produce, trade, or use any goods or services in a way that is legal
<b>eminent domain</b>	noun	the right of the government to take private property for public use; the Fifth Amendment requires that people be paid fairly (compensated) for their property if it is taken by the government
<b>forced internment</b>	noun	the confinement of a group of people, especially during a war
<b>freedom of assembly</b>	noun	the right to hold meetings and form groups without interference by the government; guaranteed in the First Amendment
<b>property rights</b>	noun	the right to own property; mentioned in the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments
