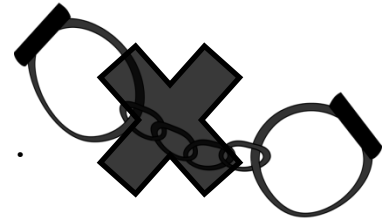

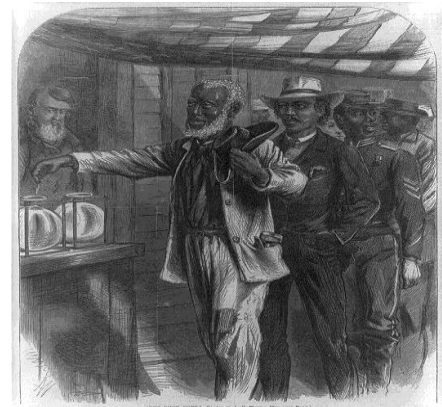

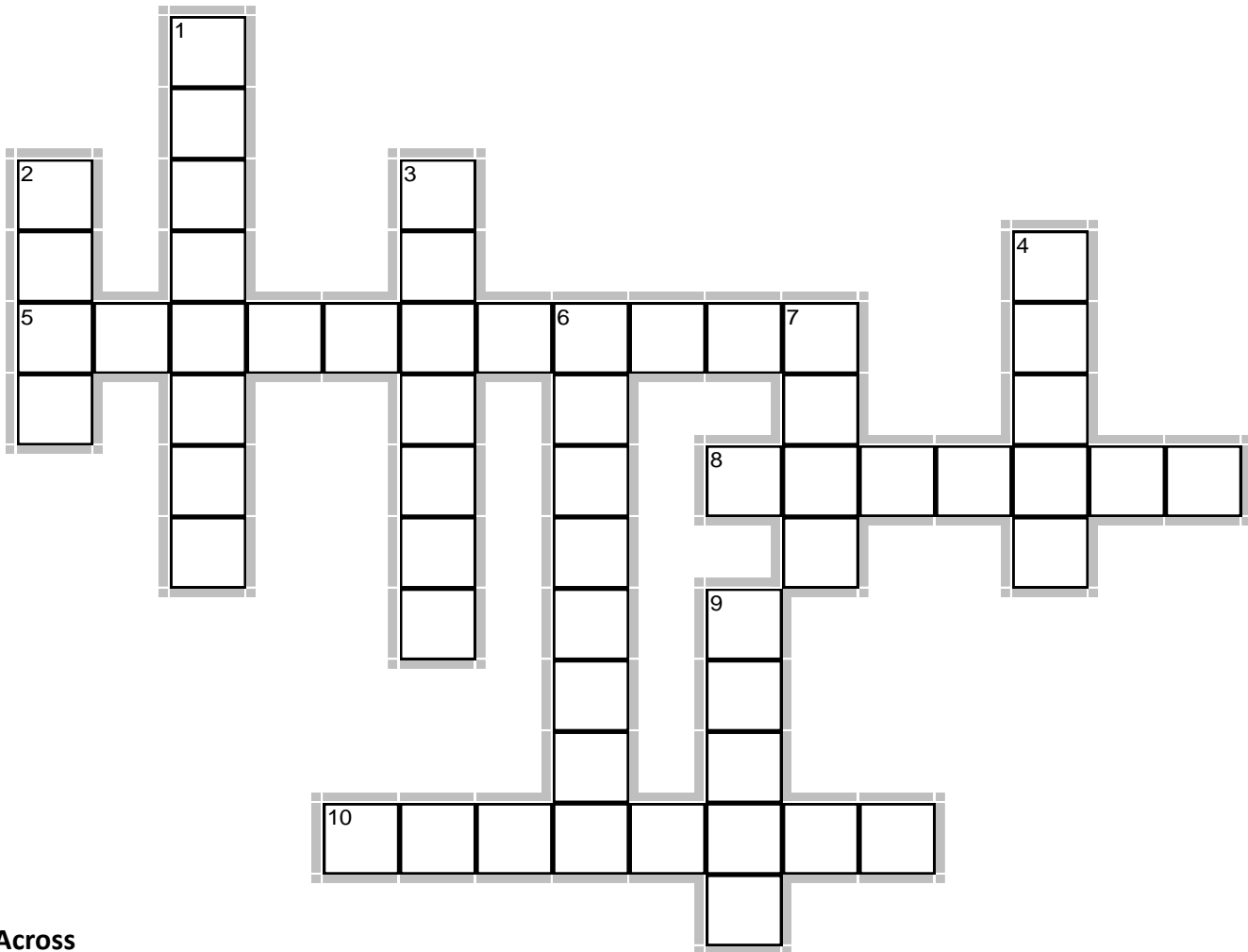
7. "The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex." \_\_\_\_\_

10. All persons born or naturalized in the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States and of the State wherein they reside.... nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws. \_\_\_\_\_
11. The right of citizens of the United States, who are eighteen years of age or older, to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of age. \_\_\_\_\_
12. The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude. \_\_\_\_\_
13. No voting qualification or prerequisite to voting, or standard, practice, or procedure shall be imposed or applied by any State or political subdivision to deny or abridge the right of any citizen of the United States to vote on account of race or color. \_\_\_\_\_
