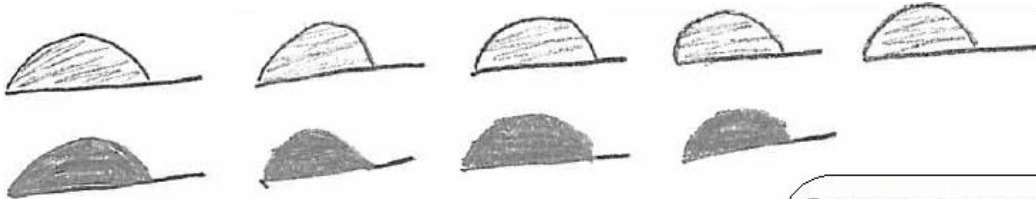

Jerry has 9 baseball hats. Draw the hats the 5-group way. Color some red and some blue. Fill in the number sentence to match.



|       |   |     |   |      |

| total |   | red |   | blue |
| 9     | = | 5   | + | 4    |

5-group way means drawing objects in rows of 5. This helps children "see" quantities easily. For example, a child can "see" that 9 is made up of 5 and 4.
