**Tuition:** \$11,000 per year (10 months, \$1,100 per month)

## **Northvale Eaglet Preschool Frequently Asked Questions:**

- 1. Will the Northvale Eaglet Preschool consist of a combination of special education preschool children and neurotypical children? Yes, it is an integrated program.
- 2. What are the school day hours? The hours will be 8:30 AM 2:30 PM, with an option to pay an additional fee for aftercare supervision until 3:00 PM.
- 3. How many preschool classrooms will there be? To start, we anticipate opening one classroom for three year old students and one classroom for four year old students.

- 4. What curriculum will be used? We will be using *The Creative Curriculum*, which is one of the four New Jersey State-approved curricula for preschool.
- 5. Will lunch be provided? Our goal will be to incorporate the preschool students into the PTO's lunch program. Of course, any parent who would like to send a lunch from home is welcome to do so.
- 6. Will snacks be provided? Snacks should be brought from home.
- 7. Will there be nap/rest time during the school day? Yes
- 8. How many bathrooms are there? There is one bathroom in each of the classrooms.
- 9. Do children need to be toilet trained? Yes. Children must be toilet trained in order to attend the Northvale Eaglet Preschool.
- 10. Will the parents of registered students be provided an opportunity to tour the classrooms? Eventually, yes, but the classrooms have not yet been furnished (see attached rendering of what the classrooms will look like) and we are still in the process of completing several building projects within the Annex.
