

DO I HAVE HOMEWORK?

Students are instructed daily to write their homework in their agenda. But, in the event they are absent they are also able to locate any assigned homework on the school homework site. Below I will demonstrate how you can create an account on the BPAS website, so that you receive notifications, whenever Mrs. Arita assigns homework.

STEP 1: Go to <https://basouth.bridgeprepacademy.com>



STEP 2: once on the school site, select Create Account
*Right on top of the parent tab

STEP 3: Fill out all information requested, you can register as a student or parent. Once you have created the account you will receive an activation email that you need to activate your account.

Personalized class lists

Automated homework notifications for parents and students

Every day, the list of homework and assignments that are due within the next 3 days will be automatically emailed to you.

Online homework submissions (only for verified student accounts if teachers allow it)

Upload your homework and assignments through our website, along with messages for your teachers. Of course, your files will be available only to you and the teacher of your class.
