Every sentence has a subject and a predicate. The subject is who or what the sentence is about and the predicate tells what the subject does. The predicate is usually located at the end of the sentence.

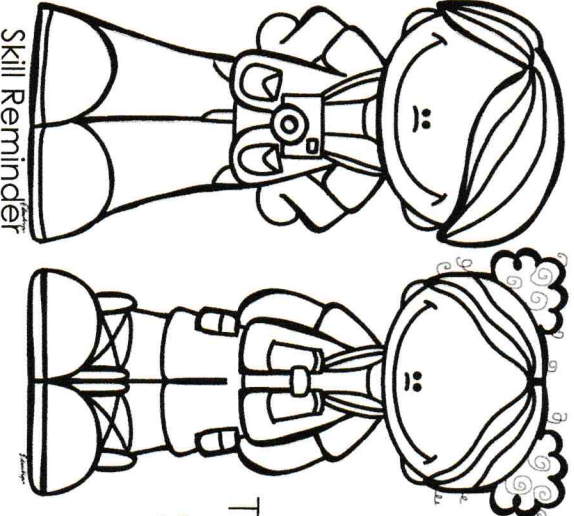
For Example;

# Amelia

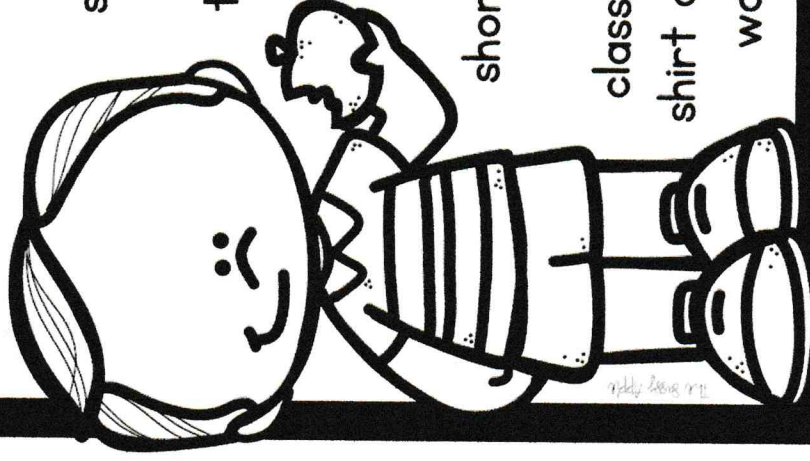

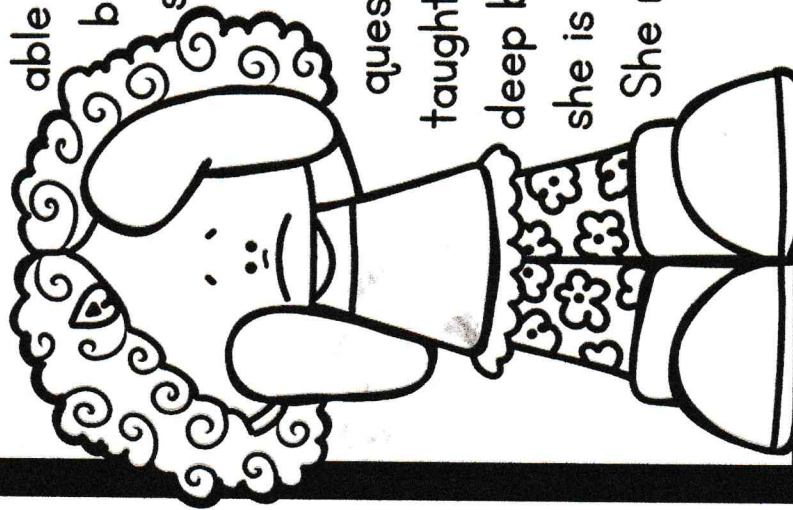


# London

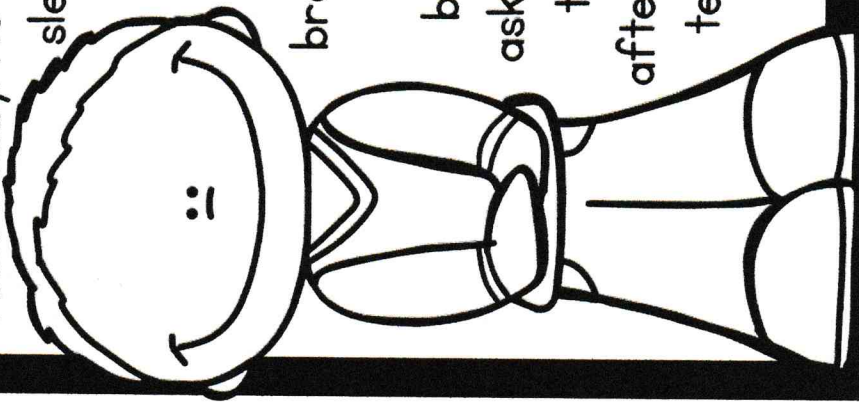
# Daniel

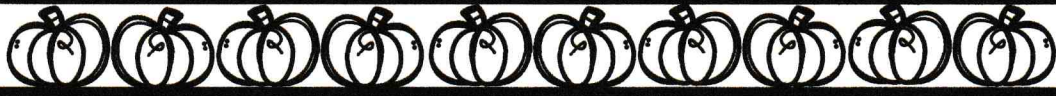

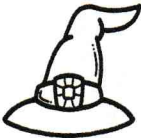

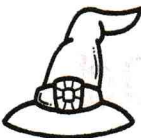
