3 Parts to an Informative Piece

Introduction	on
to Topic	

Author tells the reader what topic or book they will be discussing.

Introduction should catch the reader's attention.

Body- Facts and Details

Author supplies facts to give further information about the topic or text.

Closure

Author wraps up the informative writing piece.

Sometimes will give a call to action or ask a question.

Introductions

In informative writing, introductions are very important.

They can:
-introduce reader to topic
-introduce reader to text

This sentence comes before you begin to give facts.

Strong Ways to Begin:

-Ask a Question

-Use Onomatopoeia

-Use a Comparison

-Relate to Reader

-Quotation

-Fun Fact or Statement

-Statistic

Weak Ways to Begin:
-Saying "I am going to tell you..."
